Graduation Reqs. vs. College Reqs.

- How many years of English, Math, Science, World Language, etc. for high school vs college?
- Reminder: Graduation Reqs are just the MINIMUM credits needed.
- □ What other things do colleges consider?
 - Rigor of classes, grades earned (Transcript)
 - Progression from one year to the next (grade trends)
 - Sports, clubs, part time job, volunteer service, etc.
 - Standardized Test Scores (SAT/ACT)

Important Dates and Numbers

- □ Powerschool Course Selection Portal Open from February 4-27
- □ Minimum credits needed on schedule for 11th graders: 6.5
- □ Credits needed to be promoted to 11th grade: 12.0 credits
- □ Preliminary schedule available in PowerSchool in late May
 - Overrides: Pick levels your teachers recommend, let school counselor know if you'd like to override. Priority deadline is March 11.

There are many coping styles that people use. Some may prove more effective than others **Find out what works for YOU**


