Beginning of the Year Information

Parent/Contact Information and Communications: We ask that you sign into your PowerSchool parent portal account to verify contact and emergency contact information. Additionally, please complete the Annual Parent Update forms. The information you are verifying/providing is data that is used for school and district communications, such as School Messenger. Please verify and complete these forms prior to the first day of school. Any questions regarding your PowerSchool parent portal account or School Messenger, please contact Lisa Nagle at Inagle@swindsor.k12.ct.us.

In addition to School Messenger, the high school <u>website</u> is regularly updated and we post on Facebook at SWHS Bobcats, on Twitter @SWHSBobcats, and on Instagram @swhs_bobcats.

Bus Information: Bus routes will be available on the <u>district website</u> toward the end of August. Once on the site, go to "District Information" and click "Transportation" to access the routes.

Bell Schedules: The bell schedule for the first three days of school and the regular 2023-24 bell schedule can both be found on the high school website.

Student Schedules: Student class schedules are available in PowerSchool. Students/families who have questions regarding schedules are welcome to email their school counselor (counselors will be returning to their offices on Thursday, August 17). School counselor assignments can be <u>FOUND HERE</u>.

School Supplies: During the first days of school, teachers will make recommendations to students regarding the ideal school supplies for their courses. Students should bring charged Chromebooks on the first day of school.

Student Parking: Applications for student parking permits were due by Friday, August 4. Submitted applications are being processed on a first come, first served basis. If a student did not already apply, the application can be found here. Students who have already submitted applications can pick up their passes in the SWHS lobby beginning Friday, August 25 from 8:00 am – 2:00 pm or on the first day of school in the high school main office.

Morning Drop-Off Information: (a map of the morning drop-off areas/parking lot is located on the next page of this communication)

- **Buses** will drop off in the back of the high school and students will enter the main building through the cafeteria doors or proceed to one of the SWHS Annex entrances.
- **Student drivers** can enter the main building through the main entrance doors or proceed to one of the SWHS Annex entrances.
- Parent Drop-Off: Students being dropped off will enter the building through the main entrance doors.
- Students are reminded to use the sidewalks and crosswalks for safety reasons.

Afternoon Pick-Up Information: (a map of the afternoon bus locations, parking lots, and designated parent pick-up spot is located on the next page of this communication)

- Buses will be stationed in front of the high school in numerical order for students to board.
- Student drivers may exit each of the two student lots (gold & maroon) toward Ayers Road.
- **Designated Parent Pick-Up:** The designated spot for parents/guardians who are picking up their child is the SWHS Annex parking lot.
- Students are reminded to use the sidewalks and crosswalks for safety reasons.


Locker Information: Students can request a locker by completing a <u>locker request google form</u>. This form will be active during the month of September and lockers can be requested at any point during the first month of school. We encourage students to see where their classes are located *before* selecting a locker so they can pick one near a majority of their classes. Students must provide their own locks. A QR code to access the google form will be displayed on posters throughout the school and the form will also be posted on the school website. Students taking Physical Education classes or participating in athletics will also have access to a locker in the gym locker room area. Students must bring in a separate lock for their gym locker.

Fall Sports: If your child is interested in participating in fall SWHS athletics this year (and if you have not done so already), you must register through ECollect in the Parent Portal. You will need to submit a Physician's Statement dated after June 1, 2023 and the sports participation fee (payable to "SWHS") prior to August 3rd for football and August 18th for all other fall sports. Additional information regarding fall athletics (including the fall sports tryouts schedule) is <u>available on our school website</u> under the "Athletics" tab.
